What is the Teacher Acquisition Programme (TAP)?

TAP is an initiative of the Ministry of School and Further Education of the federal state North Rhine-Westphalia in Germany. The target is to gain teachers from abroad for teaching English as a foreign language and the subjects biology, history and geography in English.

Who can apply?

Everyone who

- can prove a university degree (bachelor/master) in either geography, history, biology, English or another foreign language
- or has worked as a history, biology, geography, English or other foreign language teacher in an English-speaking country

Which subjects are in demand?

The subjects English and biology, history and geography (classes will be conducted in English).

Where will you teach?

You may pursue your teaching career

- at secondary schools (students are between the age of 10 and 18) or
- at vocational schools and schools for further education (young adults).

What do we offer?

- **O**ne year contract. Extension up to 5 years or permanent employment.
- **A**n attractive income depending on the individual qualification and work experience between 2465 and 3835 Euros gross income per month.
- **A**ssistance with relocation.
- **C**ompetent and friendly colleagues.
- **E**ager students.
- **T**he opportunity to gain international experience.

Apply immediately. Positions are available for the beginning of the school year 2009/10 and later.
